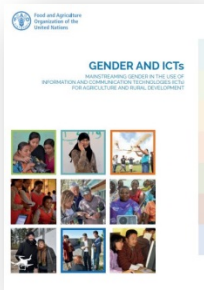

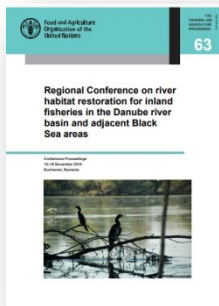

**Regional Conference on river habitat restoration for inland fisheries in the Danube River basin and adjacent Black Sea areas : conference proceedings, 13-15 November 2018, Bucharest, Romania, 2019.**

This event offered a unique opportunity for stakeholders to share their experience of the issues affecting the sustainability of the Danube river and Black Sea regions. Over 100 attendees from local community level fisherman and farmers to academics, and national and EU level representatives interacted with to 27 invited speakers. Each speaker focused on one of four session subjects Valuing Inland Fisheries Resources, Conservation and Management, Regulatory Framework and Shared Country Experiences. A round table discussion concluded the conference, with all participants invited to express their thoughts and discuss the issues affecting sustainability and inland fisheries in the Danube river basin and the Black Sea. The key findings from this concluding discussion have been compiled into a list of conference recommendations included in this publication. (*fao*)

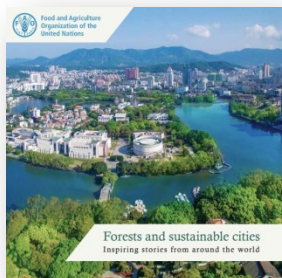

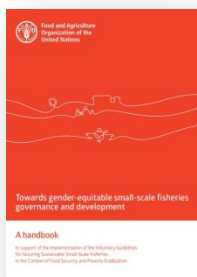

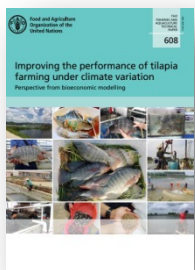
