



The State of Food and Agriculture 2017 : leveraging food systems for inclusive rural transformation, 2017.

Since the 1990s, rural transformations have helped millions of people to rise out of poverty while remaining in rural areas. This underscores an important fact: revitalizing rural economies helps create jobs for rural people, offering an alternative to those who might turn to migration in search of a better life. This year's report looks at rural and urban areas not as separate domains but as a continuum ranging from the farm level to megacities. With economic growth and population dynamics driving many societal transformations, the publication emphasizes the dynamic roles that rural towns and secondary cities play as intermediaries in boosting the rural economy. 

The State of Food Security and Nutrition in the World 2017 : building resilience for peace and food security, 2017.

After steadily declining for over a decade, global hunger appears to be on the rise with multiple forms of malnutrition threatening the health of millions. This report warns that the increase in conflicts, whose impacts are often exacerbated by climate-related shocks, is a major driver behind this shift. It also examines how food insecurity can trigger conflicts, and provides valuable insights into the role of food security in preventing the outbreak of unrest and violence. Thanks to the collaboration of five UN agencies, with WHO and UNICEF joining IFAD and WFP as partners under FAO's lead, this report is a first step towards a comprehensive global analysis of the links between food security and nutrition. 



This guide looks at how to extend the recording or registration of tenure rights to people who are currently not served by systems to record these rights. It addresses design considerations and provides practical advice on ways for a state to introduce a new system to record tenure rights as well as on how to record rights for the first time, a process that is sometimes called first registration. 

It looks at the costs of poorly functioning systems and makes recommendations for improving customer service, information and technology solutions, and legal frameworks. This paper discusses the role that social protection plays in safeguarding livelihoods while also strengthening the capacity of households to respond, cope and withstand threats and crises. It focuses on protracted crises and fragile and humanitarian contexts, and discusses the importance of shock-response systems, even in stable contexts. Challenges include system capacity neutrality and impartiality in conflict contexts, and ensuring sustainable financing. (*fao.org*)

Review of the available remote sensing tools, products, methodologies and data to improve crop production forecasts, 2017.

Timely and reliable agricultural production forecasts are critical to make informed food policy decisions and enable rapid responses to emerging food shortfalls. Sub-Saharan Africa is subject to highly variable yield, production and consumption, occasioned by high climate variability, rapidly increasing populations, and limited financial capacity. This review examines the current status of the remote sensing (RS) tools, products, methodologies and data that can help to improve agricultural crop production forecasting systems. (*fao.org*)



Greenhouse gas emissions from aquaculture : a life cycle assessment of three Asian systems, 2017.

Based on three aquaculture systems (Nile tilapia in Bangladesh, Indian major carps in India and striped catfish in Viet Nam), this publication explains where and how greenhouse gas emissions arise in Asian aquaculture. It highlights the variations within each farming system at every stage, and makes suggestions for methods that could both develop cost-effective ways of improving aquaculture and reduce related emission intensities. Planning for aquaculture diversification: the importance of climate change and other drivers, 2017.

These proceedings, from a workshop convened by FAO and World Fisheries Trust (Canada), summarize diversification successes and opportunities in all major world regions, and identify general principles to guide diversification in aquaculture. The document includes an assessment of main strategies and future steps, not only in terms of purely economic costs but also in development costs, including evaluation and mitigation of environmental and social impacts and establishment of species-specific biosecurity frameworks. While many countries in the Asia-Pacific region have made commendable efforts to set up policies, as well as administrative, legal and regulatory frameworks to properly develop and manage aquaculture, some countries are still lagging behind. And in some of the countries that have made conducive policies, implementation is delayed by a lack of financial and skilled human resources. This issue must be addressed as a priority if the Asia-Pacific aquaculture sector is to continue to develop sustainably. (*fao.org*)
